Best Growing Conditions

- 6+ hours of sun each day
- Abundant moisture with no drought stress during growing season (Mar – October)
- Rich humusy soil w/ lots of organic matter (horse manure highly recommended)
- pH 6.2-6.8



Maintenance Schedule

- Winter – cut back foliage



Maintenance Schedule

- Fertilize March

- Lawn Food (16-4-8) slow release OR
- Plant Tone OR
- Osmocote 9 mo plus Epsom Salts OR
- Horse manure plus Alfalfa pellets

- Fertilize again in July

- Hooker Formula when spraying for pests
- Add lime (if needed) anytime ground is not frozen
