

## Yard Trash

13% of municipal solid waste is yard trash



Gather twig and branches from your yard.

Using your art supplies, make something beautiful.

### Supplies

Acorns-all parts  
Paper/Posterboard  
Glue  
Twigs  
Ribbon



### Directions:

Draw an owl on the paper. Glue down the caps to cover your lines. Find a twig for the owl to rest upon. Attach to your artwork.

**OR**

*Cut a wreath shape from poster board. Glue on acorns and leaves to cover the board. Attach a ribbon and hang your wreath for everyone to enjoy.*

## Pinecone Hedgehog



### Supplies

Paper  
Scissors  
Markers  
Pinecones  
Glue

### Directions

Cut a triangular shaped face from the paper  
Draw on the eyes and nose  
Glue the face on the slender end of the cone

## Sweet Gum Flowers



### Supplies

Gum balls  
Paint supplies  
Twigs or skewers  
Glue  
Vase

### Directions

Paint the gumballs and let dry.  
Insert a branch or skewer into  
a gumball and glue together.  
Place in a vase and enjoy your  
flowers.

## Insect Hotels



Decorate a can and fill with bamboo sticks. \*There is a similar craft under the paper activities.



### Supplies

6 cleaned cans  
Silicone/E6000/Super glue  
Twigs/ dead tree parts  
Pinecones  
Cardboard-torn into pieces  
Stones

### Directions

Glue cans together and let  
the glue dry.  
Stuff all of your recycled  
material in the different  
rooms.  
\*You may not see the bugs  
because they like to be  
alone.
